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Important Info for Parents of Incoming Kindergarten Students

If you (or someone you know) is planning to send your/their child to Kindergarten for the 2024-2025 school year, the following are important dates and activities to know about:

Friday, March 1st will be our last Pre-K activity for this year. Please see the flyer on the back of this newsletter for info. This day will also be the first day of the preregistration process and to sign up for Kindergarten Screening at MVE.

March 1st, and March 4th-7th from 8a.m.-4p.m. will be Kindergarten registration at MVE. You will also sign up for K-Screening.

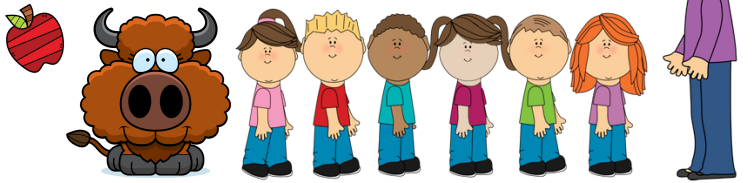
